More than conquers ...

Rom 8:35 (NKJV) Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *Shall* tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

Rom 8:36 (NKJV) As it is written: "FOR YOUR SAKE WE ARE KILLED ALL DAY LONG; WE ARE ACCOUNTED AS SHEEP FOR THE SLAUGHTER."

Rom 8:37 (NKJV) Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors (G5245) through Him who loved us.

Rom 8:37 (LIV) but despite all this, overwhelming victory (G5245) is ours through Christ who loved us enough to die for us.

From [G5228](#) and [G3528](#); to *vanquish beyond*, that is, *gain* a decisive *victory*: - more than conquer.

Rev 20:4 (NKJV) And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then *I saw* the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received *his* mark on their foreheads or on their hands. **And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.**

Rev 20:5 (NKJV) But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This *is* the first resurrection.

Rev 21:7 (NKJV) He that **overcometh shall inherit all things**; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.

1Co 3:21 (NKJV) Therefore let no one boast in men. For all things are yours:

1Co 3:22 (NKJV) whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas, or the world or life or death, or things present or things to come—**all are yours.**

1Co 3:23 (NKJV) And you *are* Christ's, and Christ *is* God's.

Rom 8:28 (NKJV) And we know that **all things work together for good** to those who love God, to those who are the called according to *His* purpose.

1Co 15:54 (NKJV) So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: "**DEATH IS SWALLOWED UP IN VICTORY.**"

1Co 15:55 (NKJV) "O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR STING? O HADES, WHERE IS YOUR VICTORY?"

1Co 15:56 (NKJV) The sting of death *is* sin, and the strength of sin *is* the law.

1Co 15:57 (NKJV) But thanks *be* to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

1Co 15:58 (NKJV) Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.

What is death?

Rom 8:6 (NKJV) **For to be carnally minded *is* death**, but to be spiritually minded *is* life and peace.

Rom 8:7 (NKJV) Because the carnal mind *is* enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be.

Overcoming is to have our mind changed to the mind of Christ.

Rom 12:2 (NKJV) And do not be conformed to this world, **but be transformed by the renewing of your mind**, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

1Co 2:16 (NKJV) For "WHO HAS KNOWN THE MIND OF THE LORD THAT HE MAY INSTRUCT HIM?" **But we have the mind of Christ.**

Num 14:8 (NKJV) **If the LORD delights in us, then He will bring us into this land and give it to us**, 'a land which flows with milk and honey.'

Num 14:9 (NKJV) Only do not rebel against the LORD, **nor fear the people of the land**, for they *are* our bread; their protection has departed from them, and the LORD *is* with us. **Do not fear them."**

Gen 41:42 (NKJV) Then Pharaoh took his signet ring off his hand and put it on Joseph's hand; and he clothed him in garments of fine linen and put a gold chain around his neck.

Gen 41:43 (NKJV) And he had him ride in the second chariot which he had; and they cried out before him, "Bow the knee!" **So he set him over all the land of Egypt.**

Gen 41:44 (NKJV) Pharaoh also said to Joseph, "I *am* Pharaoh, and without your consent no man may lift his hand or foot in all the land of Egypt."

Gen 50:20 (NKJV) **But as for you, you meant evil against me; but God meant it for good, in order to bring it about as *it is* this day, to save many people alive.**

Gen 50:21 (NKJV) Now therefore, do not be afraid; I will provide for you and your little ones." And he comforted them and spoke kindly to them.

Gen 50:24 (NKJV) And Joseph said to his brethren, "I am dying; but God will surely visit you, **and bring you out of this land to the land of which He swore to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob.**"

This is Paul talking about his process of "inheriting the land" and "overcoming" in Christ.

Php 3:10 (NKJV) that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death,

Php 3:11 (NKJV) if, by any means, **I may attain to the resurrection from the dead.**

Php 3:12 (NKJV) Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me.

Php 3:13 (NKJV) Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing *I do*, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead,

Php 3:14 (NKJV) I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

Php 3:15 (NKJV) Therefore let us, as many as are mature, have this mind; and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal even this to you.

Php 3:16 (NKJV) Nevertheless, to *the degree* that we have already attained, let us walk by the same rule, let us be of the same mind.

Php 3:17 (NKJV) Brethren, join in following my example, and note those who so walk, as you have us for a pattern.

Php 3:18 (NKJV) For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, *that they are* the enemies of the cross of Christ:

Php 3:19 (NKJV) whose end *is* destruction, **whose god is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame—who set their mind on earthly things.**

Php 3:20 (NKJV) For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ,

Php 3:21 (NKJV) who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.

We must totally dominate the land, and conquer the way God tells us to conquer.

Battle of Jericho- Joshua 6

Gideon's Army- Judges 6-8

Kill everything that breaths

Deu 20:16 (NKJV) "But of the cities of these peoples which the LORD your God gives you *as* an inheritance, **you shall let nothing that breathes remain alive,**

Deu 20:17 (NKJV) but you shall utterly destroy them: the Hittite and the Amorite and the Canaanite and the Perizzite and the Hivite and the Jebusite, just as the LORD your God has commanded you,

Deu 20:18 (NKJV) **lest they teach you to do according to all their abominations which they have done for their gods, and you sin against the LORD your God.**

It is a battle in our own minds:

2Co 10:4 (NKJV) For the weapons of our warfare **are not carnal** but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds,

2Co 10:5 (NKJV) casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, **bringing every thought** into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

2Co 10:6 (NKJV) and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled.

Eph 6:12 (NKJV) For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual *hosts* of wickedness **in the heavenly places.**

Luk 17:20 (NKJV) Now when He was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, "The kingdom of God does not come with observation;

Luk 17:21 (NKJV) nor will they say, 'See here!' or 'See there!' **For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you.**"

How is our work accomplished?

Paul plants, God gives increase

1Co 3:4 (NKJV) For when one says, "I am of Paul," and another, "I *am* of Apollos," are you not carnal?

1Co 3:5 (NKJV) Who then is Paul, and who *is* Apollos, but ministers through whom you believed, as the Lord gave to each one?

1Co 3:6 (NKJV) I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase.

1Co 3:7 (NKJV) So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase.

1Co 3:8 (NKJV) Now he who plants and he who waters are one, and each one will receive his own reward according to his own labor.

1Co 1:20 (NKJV) Where *is* the wise? Where *is* the scribe? Where *is* the disputer of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?

1Co 1:21 (NKJV) For since, in the wisdom of God, the world through wisdom did not know God, **it pleased God through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe.**

Eph 2:8 (ESV) For by grace you have been saved through faith. **And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God,**

Eph 2:9 (ESV) not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Eph 2:10 (ESV) For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

Heb 12:6 (NKJV) FOR WHOM THE LORD LOVES HE CHASTENS, AND SCOURGES EVERY SON WHOM HE RECEIVES."

Heb 12:7 (NKJV) If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten?

Heb 12:8 (NKJV) But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons.

Psa 107:21 (NKJV) Oh, that *men* would give thanks to the LORD *for* His goodness, And *for* His wonderful works to the children of men!

Psa 107:22 (NKJV) Let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, And declare His works with rejoicing.

Psa 107:23 (NKJV) Those who go down to the sea in ships, Who do business on great waters,

Psa 107:24 (NKJV) They see the works of the LORD, And His wonders in the deep.

Psa 107:25 (NKJV) For He commands and raises the stormy wind, Which lifts up the waves of the sea.

Psa 107:26 (NKJV) They mount up to the heavens, They go down again to the depths; Their soul melts because of trouble.

Psa 107:27 (NKJV) They reel to and fro, and stagger like a drunken man, And are at their wits' end.

Psa 107:28 (NKJV) Then they cry out to the LORD in their trouble, And He brings them out of their distresses.

Psa 107:29 (NKJV) He calms the storm, So that its waves are still.

Psa 107:30 (NKJV) **Then they are glad because they are quiet; So He guides them to their desired haven.**

Psa 107:31 (NKJV) Oh, that *men* would give thanks to the LORD *for* His goodness, And *for* His wonderful works to the children of men!

The Lord will finish his work:

Isa 55:11 (NKJV) So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, **But it shall accomplish what I please**, And it shall prosper *in the thing* for which I sent it.

Php 1:6 (NKJV) being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete *it* until the day of Jesus Christ;

Isa 46:9 (NKJV) Remember the former things of old, For I *am* God, and *there is* no other; I *am* God, and *there is* none like Me,

Isa 46:10 (NKJV) Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times *things* that are not yet done, Saying, '**My counsel shall stand, And I will do all My pleasure,**'
