

## **Sacrifice of Praise**

**Heb 13:15 (NKJV)** Therefore by Him let us **continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God**, that is, the fruit of *our* lips, giving thanks to His name.

**Heb 13:16 (NKJV)** But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

**Isa 28:10 (NKJV)** For precept *must be* upon precept, precept upon precept, Line upon line, line upon line, **Here a little, there a little.**"

**Psa 107:25 (NKJV)** For He commands and raises the stormy wind, Which lifts up the waves of the sea.

**Psa 107:26 (NKJV)** They mount up to the heavens, They go down again to the depths; Their soul melts because of trouble.

**Psa 107:27 (NKJV)** They reel to and fro, and stagger like a drunken man, And are at their wits' end.

**Psa 107:28 (NKJV)** Then they cry out to the LORD in their trouble, And He brings them out of their distresses.

**Psa 107:29 (NKJV)** He calms the storm, So that its waves are still.

**Psa 107:30 (NKJV)** Then they are glad because they are quiet; So He guides them to their desired haven.

**Psa 107:31 (NKJV)** Oh, that *men* would give thanks to the LORD *for* His goodness, And *for* His wonderful works to the children of men!

**Heb 12:11 (NKJV)** Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.

**Heb 12:12 (NKJV)** Therefore strengthen the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees,

**Heb 12:13 (NKJV)** and make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be *dislocated*, but rather be healed.

**Psa 22:1 (NKJV)** **To the Chief Musician. Set to "The Deer of the Dawn." a Psalm of David.** My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? *Why are You* so far from helping Me, *And from* the words of My groaning?

**Psa 22:2 (NKJV)** O My God, I cry in the daytime, but You do not hear; And in the night season, and am not silent.

**Psa 22:3 (NKJV)** But You *are* holy, Enthroned in the praises of Israel.

**Psa 22:4 (NKJV)** Our fathers trusted in You; They trusted, and You delivered them.

**Psa 22:5 (NKJV)** They cried to You, and were delivered; They trusted in You, and were not ashamed.

**Mat 27:46 (NKJV)** And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?"

**Psa 13:1 (NKJV) To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David.** How long, O LORD? Will You forget me forever? How long will You hide Your face from me?

**Psa 13:2 (NKJV)** How long shall I take counsel in my soul, *Having* sorrow in my heart daily? How long will my enemy be exalted over me?

**Psa 13:3 (NKJV)** Consider *and* hear me, O LORD my God; Enlighten my eyes, Lest I sleep the *sleep of* death;

**Psa 13:4 (NKJV)** Lest my enemy say, "I have prevailed against him"; *Lest* those who trouble me rejoice when I am moved.

**Psa 13:5 (NKJV)** But I have trusted in Your mercy; My heart shall rejoice in Your salvation.

**Psa 13:6 (NKJV)** I will sing to the LORD, Because He has dealt bountifully with me.

**Hab 1:1 (NKJV)** The **burden (prophecy)** which the prophet Habakkuk saw.

**Hab 1:2 (NKJV)** O LORD, how long shall I cry, And You will not hear? Even cry out to You, "Violence!" And You will not save.

**Hab 1:3 (NKJV)** Why do You show me iniquity, And cause *me* to see trouble? For plundering and violence *are* before me; There is strife, and contention arises.

**Hab 1:4 (NKJV)** Therefore the law is powerless, And justice never goes forth. For the wicked surround the righteous; Therefore perverse judgment proceeds.

**Ecc 1:18 (NKJV)** For in much wisdom *is* much grief, And he who increases knowledge increases sorrow.

Why?

**2Pe 3:4 (NKJV)** and saying, "Where is the promise of His coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as *they were* from the beginning of creation."

**2Pe 3:5 (NKJV)** For this they willfully forget: that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of water and in the water,

**2Pe 3:6 (NKJV)** by which the world *that* then existed perished, being flooded with water.

**2Pe 3:7 (NKJV)** But the heavens and the earth *which* are now preserved by the same word, are reserved for fire until the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.

**2Pe 3:8 (NKJV)** But, beloved, do not forget this one thing, that with the Lord one day *is* as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

**2Pe 3:9 (ESV)** The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.

**2Pe 3:10 (ESV)** But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a roar, and the heavenly bodies will be burned up and dissolved, and the earth and the works that are done on it will be exposed.

When you see other suffer:

**Luk 13:1 (NKJV)** There were present at that season some who told Him about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices.

**Luk 13:2 (NKJV)** And Jesus answered and said to them, "Do you suppose that these Galileans were worse sinners than all *other* Galileans, because they suffered such things?

**Luk 13:3 (NKJV)** I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish.

**Luk 13:4 (NKJV)** Or those eighteen on whom the tower in Siloam fell and killed them, do you think that they were worse sinners than all *other* men who dwelt in Jerusalem?

**Luk 13:5 (NKJV)** I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish."

**Pro 24:17 (NKJV)** Do not rejoice when your enemy falls, And do not let your heart be glad when he stumbles;

**Pro 24:18 (NKJV)** Lest the LORD see it, and it displease Him, And He turn away His wrath from him.

Why are we weak?

**2Co 12:9 (NKJV)** And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

**2Co 12:10 (NKJV)** Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

**1Co 1:25 (NKJV)** Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

**1Co 1:26 (NKJV)** For you see your calling, brethren, that not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, *are called*.

**1Co 1:27 (NKJV)** But God has chosen the foolish things of the world to put to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the world to put to shame the things which are mighty;

**1Co 1:28 (NKJV)** and the base things of the world and the things which are despised God has chosen, and the things which are not, to bring to nothing the things that are,

**1Co 1:29 (NKJV)** that no flesh should glory in His presence.

**Pro 30:8 (NKJV)** Remove falsehood and lies far from me; Give me neither poverty nor riches—Feed me with the food allotted to me;

**Pro 30:9 (NKJV)** Lest I be full and deny You, And say, "Who is the LORD?" Or lest I be poor and steal, And profane the name of my God.

**Psa 25:3 (NKJV)** Indeed, let no one who waits on You be ashamed; Let those be ashamed who deal treacherously without cause.

**Rom 10:11 (NKJV)** For the Scripture says, "WHOEVER BELIEVES ON HIM WILL NOT BE PUT TO SHAME."

**Pro 13:12 (ESV)** Hope deferred makes the heart sick, but a desire fulfilled is a tree of life.

**Psa 73:1 (NKJV)** **A Psalm of Asaph.** Truly God *is* good to Israel, To such as are pure in heart.

**Psa 73:2 (NKJV)** But as for me, my feet had almost stumbled; My steps had nearly slipped.

**Psa 73:3 (NKJV)** For I *was* envious of the boastful, When I saw the prosperity of the wicked.

**Psa 73:4 (NKJV)** For *there are* no pangs in their death, But their strength *is* firm.

**Psa 73:5 (NKJV)** They *are* not in trouble *as other* men, Nor are they plagued like *other* men.

**Psa 73:6 (NKJV)** Therefore pride serves as their necklace; Violence covers them *like* a garment.

**Psa 73:7 (NKJV)** Their eyes bulge with abundance; They have more than heart could wish.

**Psa 73:8 (NKJV)** They scoff and speak wickedly *concerning* oppression; They speak loftily.

**Psa 73:9 (NKJV)** They set their mouth against the heavens, And their tongue walks through the earth.

**Psa 73:10 (NKJV)** Therefore his people return here, And waters of a full *cup* are drained by them.

**Psa 73:11 (NKJV)** And they say, "How does God know? And is there knowledge in the Most High?"

**Psa 73:12 (NKJV)** Behold, these *are* the ungodly, Who are always at ease; They increase *in* riches.

**Psa 73:13 (NKJV)** Surely I have cleansed my heart *in* vain, And washed my hands in innocence.

**Psa 73:14 (NKJV)** For all day long I have been plagued, And chastened every morning.

**Psa 73:15 (NKJV)** If I had said, "I will speak thus," Behold, I would have been untrue to the generation of Your children.

**Psa 73:16 (NKJV)** When I thought *how* to understand this, It *was* too painful for me—

**Psa 73:17 (NKJV)** Until I went into the sanctuary of God; *Then* I understood their end.

**Psa 73:18 (NKJV)** Surely You set them in slippery places; You cast them down to destruction.

**Psa 73:19 (NKJV)** Oh, how they are *brought* to desolation, as in a moment! They are utterly consumed with terrors.

**Psa 73:20 (NKJV)** As a dream when *one* awakes, *So*, Lord, when You awake, You shall despise their image.

**Psa 73:21 (NKJV)** Thus my heart was grieved, And I was vexed in my mind.

**Psa 73:22 (NKJV)** I *was* so foolish and ignorant; I was *like* a beast before You.

**Psa 73:23 (NKJV)** Nevertheless I *am* continually with You; You hold *me* by my right hand.

**Psa 73:24 (NKJV)** You will guide me with Your counsel, And afterward receive me *to* glory.

**Psa 73:25 (NKJV)** Whom have I in heaven *but* You? And *there is* none upon earth *that* I desire besides You.

**Psa 73:26 (NKJV)** My flesh and my heart fail; *But* God *is* the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

**Psa 73:27 (NKJV)** For indeed, those who are far from You shall perish; You have destroyed all those who desert You for harlotry.

**Psa 73:28 (NKJV)** But *it is* good for me to draw near to God; I have put my trust in the Lord GOD, That I may declare all Your works.

**Php 1:21 (NKJV)** For to me, to live *is* Christ, and to die *is* gain.

**Php 1:22 (NKJV)** But if *I* live on in the flesh, this *will mean* fruit from *my* labor; yet what I shall choose I cannot tell.

**Php 1:23 (NKJV)** For I am hard-pressed between the two, having a desire to depart and be with Christ, *which is* far better.

**Php 1:24 (NKJV)** Nevertheless to remain in the flesh *is* more needful for you.

**Php 1:25 (NKJV)** And being confident of this, I know that I shall remain and continue with you all for your progress and joy of faith,

**Php 1:26 (NKJV)** that your rejoicing for me may be more abundant in Jesus Christ by my coming to you again.

**Psa 135:3 (NKJV)** Praise the LORD, for the LORD *is* good; Sing praises to His name, for *it is* pleasant.

**Rev 21:4 (NKJV)** And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away."

**Rev 21:5 (NKJV)** Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful."

**Eph 3:20 (ESV)** Now to him who is **able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us,**

**Eph 3:21 (ESV)** to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

**Php 4:19 (NKJV)** And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

**Php 4:20 (NKJV)** Now to our God and Father be glory forever and ever. Amen.

**1Th 5:18 (NKJV)** in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.
