Mat 5:13 (NKJV) "You are the **salt of the earth**; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men.

Mat 5:14 (NKJV) "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden.

Mat 5:15 (NKJV) Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all *who are* in the house.

Mat 5:16 (NKJV) Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

Col 4:5 (NKJV) Walk in wisdom toward those *who are* outside, redeeming the time.

2Pe 1:3 (NKJV) as His divine power has given to us all things that *pertain* to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue,

2Pe 1:4 (NKJV) by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, **having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.**

2Pe 1:5 (NKJV) But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your **faith** virtue, to virtue knowledge,

2Pe 1:6 (NKJV) to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness,

2Pe 1:7 (NKJV) to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love.

2Pe 1:8 (NKJV) For if these things are yours and abound, *you will be* **neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.**

2Pe 1:9 (NKJV) For he who lacks these things is shortsighted, even to blindness, and has forgotten that he was cleansed from his old sins.

2Pe 1:10 (NKJV) Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your call and election sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble;

2Pe 1:14 (NKJV) knowing that shortly I *must* put off my tent, just as our Lord Jesus Christ showed me.

2Pe 1:15 (NKJV) Moreover I will be careful to ensure that you always have a reminder of these things after my decease.

Heb 11:6 (NKJV) **But without faith *it is impossible to please Him***, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a **rewarder** of those who diligently seek Him.

Mat 7:7 (NKJV) "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.

Mat 7:8 (NKJV) For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.

Mat 7:9 (NKJV) Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone?

Luk 7:9 (NKJV) When Jesus heard these things, He marveled at him, and turned around and said to the crowd that followed Him, "**I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel!**"

Luk 7:10 (NKJV) And those who were sent, returning to the house, found the servant well who had been sick.

Spies sent into the promise land:

Num 13:27 (NKJV) Then they told him, and said: "We went to the land where you sent us. It truly flows with milk and honey, and this *is* its fruit.

Num 13:28 (NKJV) Nevertheless the people who dwell in the land *are* strong; the cities *are* fortified *and* very large; moreover we saw the descendants of Anak there.

Num 13:29 (NKJV) The Amalekites dwell in the land of the South; the Hittites, the Jebusites, and the Amorites dwell in the mountains; and the Canaanites dwell by the sea and along the banks of the Jordan."

Num 13:30 (NKJV) Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses, and said, "Let us go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to overcome it."

Num 13:31 (NKJV) But the men who had gone up with him said, "**We are not able to go up against the people, for they *are* stronger than we.**"

Num 13:32 (NKJV) And they gave the children of Israel a bad report of the land which they had spied out, saying, "The land through which we have gone as spies *is* a land that devours its inhabitants, and all the people whom we saw in it *are* men of *great* stature.

Num 13:33 (NKJV) There we saw the giants (the descendants of Anak came from the giants); and we were like grasshoppers in our own sight, and so we were in their sight."

Rom 7:22 (NKJV) For I delight in the law of God according to the inward man.

Rom 7:23 (NKJV) But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

Rom 7:24 (NKJV) **O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death?**

Num 14:1 (NKJV) So all the congregation lifted up their voices and cried, and the people wept that night.

Num 14:2 (NKJV) And all the children of Israel complained against Moses and Aaron, and the whole congregation said to them, "**If only we had died in the land of Egypt!** Or if only we had died in this wilderness!

Num 14:3 (NKJV) Why has the LORD brought us to this land to fall by the sword, that our wives and children should become victims? Would it not be better for us to return to Egypt?"

Num 14:4 (NKJV) So they said to one another, "Let us select a leader and return to Egypt."

Num 14:5 (NKJV) Then Moses and Aaron fell on their faces before all the assembly of the congregation of the children of Israel.

Num 14:6 (NKJV) But Joshua the son of Nun and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, *who were* among those who had spied out the land, tore their clothes;

Num 14:7 (NKJV) and they spoke to all the congregation of the children of Israel, saying: "The land we passed through to spy out *is* an exceedingly good land.

Num 14:8 (NKJV) **If the LORD delights in us, then He will bring us into this land and give it to us, 'a land which flows with milk and honey.'**

Heb 11:6 (NKJV) **But without faith *it is impossible to please Him,*** for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a **rewarder** of those who diligently seek Him.

What is the reward?

Joh 18:36 (NKJV) Jesus answered, "My kingdom is not of this world. If My kingdom were of this world, My servants would fight, so that I should not be delivered to the Jews; but now My kingdom is not from here."

Mat 6:19 (NKJV) "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal;

Mat 6:20 (NKJV) but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal.

Mat 6:21 (NKJV) For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Mat 6:22 (NKJV) "The lamp of the body is the eye. If therefore your eye is good, your whole body will be full of light.

Mat 6:23 (NKJV) But if your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in you is darkness, how great *is* that darkness!

Mat 6:24 (NKJV) "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.

Rom 14:14 (NKJV) I know and am convinced by the Lord Jesus that *there is* nothing unclean of itself; but to him who considers anything to be unclean, to him *it is* unclean.

Rom 14:15 (NKJV) Yet if your brother is grieved because of *your* food, you are no longer walking in love. Do not destroy with your food the one for whom Christ died.

Rom 14:16 (NKJV) Therefore do not let your good be spoken of as evil;

Rom 14:17 (NKJV) **for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.**

1Jn 2:15 (NKJV) Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

1Jn 2:16 (NKJV) For all that *is* in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.

1Jn 2:17 (NKJV) And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.

Mar 4:18 (NKJV) Now these are the ones sown among thorns; *they are* the ones who hear the word,

Mar 4:19 (NKJV) and the cares of this world, the deceitfulness of riches, and the desires for other things entering in choke the word, and it becomes unfruitful.

Num 14:9 (NKJV) Only do not rebel against the LORD, **nor fear the people of the land, for they *are* our bread**; their protection has departed from them, and the LORD *is* with us. Do not fear them."

Mat 10:29 (NKJV) Are not two sparrows sold for a copper coin? And not one of them falls to the ground apart from your Father's will.

Mat 10:30 (NKJV) But the very hairs of your head are all numbered.

Mat 10:31 (NKJV) **Do not fear therefore**; you are of more value than many sparrows.

** The phrases "do not fear" and "do not be afraid" appear in 99 verses in the NKJV translation.

The most common emotion I have experienced in my life is fear. It was the first study I ever did.

The concept of fear is very prevalent in scripture. The word fear appears 385 times, while the word joy appears only 155 times. This life is very difficult, and often frightening. Hopefully this study on fear will shed some light on what fear is and how we are to deal with it.
